
Men's Auxiliary President: Stewart Pike Next Meeting: 10 NOV 2011 7PM





If you haven't renewed yet, please do so ASAP!!!






The Annual dues, is still \$25.00. That is really nothing compared to what some businesses spend on lobbyists in Washington in a year. Let's make this happen.




